

## Senators COVID-19 Pool hours and rules June 16, 2020

### Pool hours (8 AM - 8 PM daily)

**8 AM - 8 PM Weekdays and 8-11 AM and 5-8 PM Weekends - *Unmonitored swimming*** (max 50 people). This is self-governed, non-monitored swim time. If you're the 51st person, wait outside the pool area.

**11 AM - 5 PM Weekends - *Monitored swimming*** (max 80 people) IF a Pool Monitor is present (if not, revert to unmonitored max 50 people)

### Monitored open for swimming times (max 80 people) 11-5 Weekends and Holidays

- If the POOL CLOSED sign is on the gate, we've exceeded capacity. DO NOT ENTER. Wait for volunteer monitor to re-open the pool to new guests.

### Pool Covid19 Rules

- By entering the pool, you are taking responsibility for your own protection, disinfecting your hands and anything you touch in the pool area.
- Wash your hands at the tiki bar wash station immediately upon arrival
- Bathers should review signs and symptoms of COVID-19 before heading to the pool
- Observe Social Distancing - maintain at least 6 feet of separation except same household members
- Face coverings are recommended when not swimming
- Face coverings are not recommended for children under 12
- When the pool is at capacity, the monitor will put the closed sign on the gate.

### Unavailable for use to minimize our sanitization load

- Clubhouse, restrooms, gym and kitchen (the entire building)
- Outdoor Grills, Fireplace and tiki bar (excepting hand washing station)
- Pool furniture. Bring your own chairs. Do not leave chairs when you're not present

### Permitted

- Arm floats (swimmies) or vests for children under 6. No sharing out of household
- Pool toys limited to sinking pool toys for diving (2 per person)

### Prohibited

- Group games involving people interacting in close proximity.
- Occupying the "pool monitor station". This table and umbrella are solely for the pool monitor's use.
